

LEC XL - 2019
FIREARMS SAFETY RULES

1. All weapons are to be unloaded upon arrival at the range.
2. Keep all weapons holstered unless on the firing line. Unholster only upon command.
3. No "dry firing" except upon command of the range officer.
4. No smoking or talking on the firing line.
5. Keep weapons pointed down-range at all times.
6. Load weapons only on the firing line and only on command.
7. Never anticipate a command.
8. Never go forward of the firing line until the line has been cleared and the command to do so has been given.
9. Misfires and malfunctions. Wait ten seconds after a misfire, and then try firing the cartridge again. If it continues to misfire, raise your hand, and wait for a range officer to assist you. Do not place it with the empty brass.

Do not fire a succeeding shot after a malfunction until barrel has been examined for obstructions.
10. Call out loudly if you do not understand any command, if you are not ready, or if you observe any safety hazard.

TREAT ALL GUNS AS THOUGH THEY WERE LOADED.

NEVER POINT A FIREARM AT ANYONE UNLESS YOU ARE READY AND WILLING TO KILL THAT PERSON.

NEVER DRAW A WEAPON FROM THE HOLSTER WITH THE FINGER INSIDE THE TRIGGER GUARD.
