

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EXPLORERS LEC XL - 2019

1. **ALCOHOL AND SMOKING:** There is NO alcohol or smoking allowed at the barracks at this facility. Smoking is allowed in designated areas only. Please pick up your own butts, no one else wants to do that! Please be respectful so we don't have an incident of embarrassment for law enforcement.
2. There will be separate sleeping quarters for male and female Explorer/Cadets. You will not be allowed in any sleeping quarters but your own – violations will result in reduction in your Post's score.
3. Sleeping quarters are off limits during the day. You must have an Advisor accompany you to the dorms. An area will be available for studying, visiting, and report writing.
4. Competition will be done in BDU's or jeans and uniform shirt. The only exception to this would be a new Explorer/Cadet who does not yet have a uniform shirt. A uniform should be worn for the awards ceremony.
5. If you bring electronic equipment we will NOT be responsible for lost or stolen items. You bring them at your own risk.
6. Explorer/Cadets must write their own reports. They can NOT be assisted by their Advisors.
7. If an Explorer/Cadet is found in violation of these rules and regulations, the following actions will occur:
 - a. Their Advisor will be notified.
 - b. The Staff will be notified.
 - c. The offender's Post's standing in the competition may be lowered as a penalty.
 - d. The offender may be dismissed from the conference.
 - e. The offender's sponsoring agency may be notified of the incident.The Staff will be solely responsible for discipline regarding reduction of points in Post standings, for dismissals from the conference, and for notification of the sponsoring agency. This will not prevent an Advisor from disciplining Post members when necessary.
8. Fees are not refundable. Once received, if a Post member decides not to come you may substitute another Post member. That person may compete in all the events for which you have registered, if they desire. The staff must be notified of any substitutions.

9. Weapons will be secured as directed by LEC Staff, unless being used in an official capacity.
Explorers/Cadets are not allowed to carry weapons during the conference except at the range and during their competition.
10. All weapons must be what your agency has authorized you to carry. You will provide your own ammunition and leather. No exceptions.
11. Pistol competition will be on a 25-yard course, 50 rounds, one shoot per entrant. A second shoot may be necessary to resolve ties.
12. No slugging devices, gas, or mace at the camp.
13. **GENERAL CONDUCT:** All persons shall act in a manner becoming to the police profession, to Law Enforcement Exploring, and to their sponsoring agency.
14. **WANDERING:** Participants shall remain in those areas designated for use by the conference. NO PARTICIPANT SHALL NOT LEAVE THE GROUNDS DURING THE CONFERENCE WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE STAFF. THEY MUST CHECK OUT AT THE STAFF HEADQUARTERS.
15. **PUNCTUALITY:** Participants shall be at the appointed event location and ready to start at the time designated on the schedule or as otherwise posted by the Staff.
16. **VEHICLES:** Vehicles should be parked unless they are being used in scenarios. There is limited parking at this facility. We will try to provide Post designated parking. They are also **very** strict about speeding on the base.
17. If an Advisor feels there is a violation, and it is not covered in these rules and regulations, the Advisor shall contact the Staff and a final decision will be made.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADVISORS

1. The **NO ALCOHOL/NO SMOKING** policies apply to all participants. This includes the parking lots or in private vehicles. Remember, we are role models for the Explorers/Cadets.
2. **ADVISORS:** Each Post in attendance must furnish an advisor to be present at all times during the conference for male and female Explorers/Cadets. These Advisors must remain at the conference, on the site, throughout the entire conference unless their Post leaves. Advisors may arrange for a substitute, but the Staff must be advised of the substitution.

3. All Post Advisors have supervisory responsibility for any Explorer/Cadet at the conference, regardless of what Post they are attached to. All Advisors have been instructed to report all violations, and violations may lower your Post standing in the weekend competition.
